

Information about cookies

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small piece of text sent to your browser by a website that you visit. When you go back to the same site the cookie will help the site to remember your browser. Cookies are useful because they allow the website to recognise the user's computer. Cookies make it possible to browse the net efficiently and to remember your preferences. The cookies that will be sent to your computer during our activity will be subject to processing based on the principles of accuracy, legality and transparency to protect your confidentiality and rights. No personal data is saved in these cookies; the cookies that we use are not attributable to a specific person and therefore not related to you.

This site uses technical cookies in accordance with article 122, paragraph 1, of Italian Legislative Decree no. 196/2003. These cookies are of vital importance for our Website to work correctly. Without them you would not be able to browse the site and use some of its functions. We use session cookies (that are not permanently stored on the user's computer and disappear when you close the browser) that are strictly limited to transmitting session identifiers (made up of random numbers generated by the server) that are necessary to allow secure and efficient browsing of the site. Essential cookies make it possible to remember the information you supply from page to page of the booking process or allow you to browse on the basis of a series of selected criteria to improve the service we want to offer you (like remember the preferred language and the products selected for purchase).

If you wish you can allow, block or eliminate cookies installed on your computer by modifying the settings on your browser. Below is the procedure to follow depending on the type of browser you use:

Firefox:

1. Open Firefox
2. Press the "Alt" button on the keyboard
3. Click on "Tools" at the top of your browser window and select "Options"
4. Then select the "Privacy" icon
5. Go to "History Settings": and then "Use custom settings". Deselect "Allow cookies from sites" and save your preferences.

Internet Explorer:

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Click on "Tools" at the top of your browser window and select "Internet Options"
3. Select "Privacy" and move the slider to set your desired privacy level (upwards to block all cookies and downwards to allow all)
4. Then click OK

Google Chrome:

1. Open Google Chrome
2. Click on "Tools"
3. Select "Settings" and then "Advanced Settings"

4. Select "Content settings" in the "Privacy" section
5. In the "Cookies" section it is possible to deselect cookies and save your preferences

Safari:

1. Open Safari
2. Select the "Preferences" option in the tool bar and then select the "Security" panel in the following dialogue box
3. In the "Accept cookies" section it is possible to specify if and when Safari should save cookies from websites. For more information click on the Help button (marked by a question mark)
4. For more information on the cookies that are stored on your computer, click on "View cookies"
